Uniform Policy

KINDY – YEAR 6 GIRLS UNIFORM

Dress:	College dress available from College uniform shop.
	Guidelines: Dresses must be touching the knee when standing straight and no shorter than approximately 0.5 cm off the floor when kneeling. Dresses may be worn longer if desired but not shorter.
	Ensure that a 'blind hem' is used when hemming dresses. Please ensure that a generous hem allowance is maintained for future years. All raw edges need to be over locked. Please understand that if the dress has been permanently shortened above the allowed length, you will be made to purchase a new dress and your child will not be allowed back to school until they are wearing the regulation length.
Jumper:	College jumper available from College uniform shop.
	Jumper can be worn with the formal dress uniform and the sport uniform. No other jumpers will be accepted. The College Sports Jacket can be worn over the College jumper for extra warmth. The Sports Jacket cannot be worn with the formal uniform without the College jumper.
Socks:	College issue white ankle socks with TVAC logo available from the College uniform shop. (Winter Option: Navy opaque tights or stockings free of holes and in good condition. No patterns allowed.) White socks are not to be worn over the top of tights.
Hair:	Hair accessories are to be simple and unadorned with lace, flowers, bows etc. Navy, white or light blue accessories. Hair must be kept away from the face. Hair that is below the shoulder in length must be tied up. Hair colour is to be natural in appearance.
Sport:	College issue unisex navy shorts with College logo available from College uniform shop.
	College issue unisex navy polo shirt with College logo available from College uniform shop.
	College issue white ankle socks with College logo available from the College uniform shop.
	College issue jumper or sport jacket with College logo.
	Optional: College issue track pants and sports jacket Can be ordered from uniform shop. Please note that the track pants can only be worn on sport days.
Hat:	Navy College issued bucket hat. Strict 'NO SHARE' policy. NO HAT, NO PLAY.
Dress Shoes:	Black, leather or synthetic 'leather look' polished 'Clarke' style school shoes only are to be worn with the formal dress uniform. No pattern or embellished stitching is allowed. Shoes should offer appropriate heel and arch support with heels no higher than 3 cm. The toes should be completely enclosed. Slipper, ballerina or flat-soled shoes, skate/street shoes, Volleys, canvas shoes, hiking shoes or black leather Lynx style runners will not be allowed.
	Kindy and Year 1 students may wear black leather or synthetic 'leather look' polished school shoes with a Velcro fastening if they cannot tie their shoe laces. These shoes must resemble the lace up version and may not be the Mary Jane style.
Sport Shoes:	Kindergarten to Year 12
	Type: Sport Shoes must be lace up runners / sneakers / joggers / cross trainers.
	Colour: Students may wear any appropriate sport shoe that will provide support and protection for their feet. This does not include skate shoes, street shoes, volleys or canvas converse shoes as they do not provide the support required for physical activity. Please understand that students will not be able to participate in sport, PE or representative duties if they are not wearing correct shoes.
	A final decision on sport shoes will always be at the discretion of the College Administration.
Jewellery:	Gold or silver plain stud earrings only (Size 3-4mm). One stud per earlobe is permitted. Any other jewellery worn will be confiscated until the end of the term. Any piercing is to be done over the Christmas break. Minimum 6 weeks before return to College. Retainers are not to be used with the uniform.

Make-up:	Nail polish, if worn, is to be natural. Facial make-up, if worn, is to be natural in colour and discreet.
Undergarments:	Girls undergarments are to be natural in colour (i.e. no black or bright colours) when worn under the white sport polo. Singlets are to be tucked in and not visible below the bottom of shirts.

The College uniform is to be worn completely and correctly at all times on and off campus. This includes shirts tucked in, socks pulled up, and correct jumper.

Non-Uniform Day Guidelines – Students are to dress modestly on free dress days. For girls, no singlets or tank tops allowed and shorts must come to the bottom of their fingers when standing straight with arms by their side. Low cut tops are not to be worn. The jewellery policy still applies to free dress days. For safety reasons, students must wear covered in shoes. A free dress hat must be worn in all outdoor activities – PE, recess and lunch.

KINDY – YEAR 6 BOYS UNIFORM

Shorts:	College issue midnight navy flexi-waist available from the College uniform shop.
Shirts:	College issue sky blue short sleeve shirts available from the College uniform shop.
Socks:	College issue grey socks with stripe available from the College uniform shop.
Jumper:	College jumper available from the College uniform shop.
	Jumper can be worn with the formal dress uniform and the sport uniform. No other jumpers will be accepted. The College Sports Jacket can be worn over the College jumper for extra warmth. It cannot be worn with the formal uniform without the College jumper.
Hair:	Hair must be tidy, short and clear of the collar, ears and eyebrows. Student haircuts must trend toward a conservative style. Hair should not be shorter than a No 2 blade clipper. Hair product may be sensibly used if it helps the student comply with the code. Hair colour should look natural. Boys must be clean-shaven.
	Students may be excluded from school until their hair meets the hair policy requirements. A final decision on hair will always be at the discretion of the College Administration.
Sport:	College issue unisex navy shorts with College logo available from College uniform shop.
	College issue unisex navy polo shirt with College logo available from College uniform shop.
	College issue white ankle socks with TVAC logo available from the College uniform shop.
	College issue jumper or sport jacket with College logo.
	Optional: College issue track pants and sports jacket Can be ordered from uniform shop. Please note that the track pants can only be worn on sport days.
Hat:	Navy College issued bucket hat. Strict 'NO SHARE' policy. NO HAT, NO PLAY
Dress Shoes:	Black, leather or synthetic 'leather look' polished 'Clarke' style school shoes only are to be worn with the formal dress uniform. No pattern or embellished stitching is allowed. Shoes should offer appropriate heel and arch support. The toes should be completely enclosed. Flat-soled shoes, skate/street shoes, Volleys, canvas shoes, hiking shoes or black leather Lynx style runners will not be allowed.

Sport Shoes:	Kindergarten to Year 12
	Type: Sport Shoes must be lace up runners / sneakers / joggers / cross trainers.
	Colour: Students may wear any appropriate sport shoe that will provide support and protection for their feet. This does not include skate shoes, street shoes, volleys or canvas converse shoes as they do not provide the support required for physical activity. Please understand that students will not be able to participate in sport, PE or representative duties if they are not wearing correct shoes.
	A final decision on sport shoes will always be at the discretion of the College Administration.
Jewellery:	No jewellery is to be worn. Any jewellery worn will be confiscated until the end of the term. Any piercing is to be done over the Christmas break. Minimum 6 weeks before return to College. Retainers are not to be used with the uniform.
Undergarments:	T-shirts and singlets worn under the uniform must be white and not have emblems or slogans etc visible under or

F-shirts and singlets worn under the uniform must be **white** and **not have** emblems or slogans etc visible under or Undergarments: through the uniform. Singlets are to be tucked in and not visible below the bottom of shirts.

The College uniform is to be worn completely and correctly at all times on and off campus. This includes shirts tucked in, socks pulled up, and correct jumper.

YEARS 7–12 GIRLS UNIFORM

Skirt:	Available from College uniform shop. Guidelines: Skirts must be touching the knee when standing straight and no shorter than approximately 0.5 cm off the floor when kneeling. Skirts may be worn longer if desired but not shorter. Ensure that a 'blind hem' is used when hemming skirts. Please ensure that a generous hem allowance is maintained for future years and that a professional finish is obtained. All raw edges need to be over locked. Please understand that if the skirt has been permanently shortened above the allowed length you will be made to purchase a new skirt and your child will not be allowed back to school until they are wearing the regulation length.
Blouse:	Available from College uniform shop.
Tie:	Regulation Navy button on crossover tie from the College uniform shop – Years 7-10 Regulation 'Men's' style Navy button on tie from the College uniform shop – Senior Yr 1and Yr 2
Jumper:	College jumper available from College uniform shop. Jumper can be worn with the formal dress uniform and the sport uniform. No other jumpers will be accepted. The College Sports Jacket can be worn over the College jumper for extra warmth. It cannot be worn with the formal uniform without the College jumper.
Socks:	College issue white ankle socks with TVAC logo available from the College uniform shop. (Winter Option: Navy opaque tights or stockings free of holes and in good condition. No patterns allowed.) White socks are not to be worn over the top of tights.
Hair:	Hair accessories are to be simple and unadorned with lace, flowers, bows etc. Navy, white or light blue accessories. Hair must be kept away from the face. Hair that is below the shoulder in length must be tied up. Hair colour is to be natural in appearance.

Hat:	Navy College bucket hat from the uniform shop. NO HAT, NO PLAY.
Dress Shoes:	Black, leather or synthetic 'leather look' polished 'Clarke' style school shoes only are to be worn with the formal dress uniform. No pattern or embellished stitching is allowed. Shoes should offer appropriate heel and arch support with heels no higher than 3 cm. The toes should be completely enclosed. Slipper, ballerina or flat-soled shoes, skate/street shoes, Volleys, canvas shoes, hiking shoes or black leather Lynx style runners will not be allowed.
Sport Shoes:	Kindergarten to Year 12
	Type: Sport Shoes must be lace up runners / sneakers / joggers / cross trainers.
	Colour: Students may wear any appropriate sport shoe that will provide support and protection for their feet. This does not include skate shoes, street shoes, volleys or canvas converse shoes as they do not provide the support required for physical activity. Please understand that students will not be able to participate in sport, PE or representative duties if they are not wearing correct shoes.
	A final decision on sport shoes will always be at the discretion of the College Administration.
Jewellery:	Gold or silver plain stud earrings only (Size 3-4mm). One stud per earlobe is permitted. Any other jewellery worn will be confiscated until the end of the term. Any piercing is to be done over the Christmas break. Minimum 6 weeks before return to College. Retainers are not to be used with the uniform.
Make-up:	Nail polish, if worn, is to be natural. Facial make-up, if worn, is to be natural in colour and discreet.
Undergarments:	Girls undergarments are to be natural in colour (i.e. no black or bright colours) when worn under the white sport shirt. T-shirts and singlets worn under the uniform must be white and not have emblems or slogans etc visible under or through the uniform. Singlets are to be tucked in and not visible below the bottom of shirts.

The College uniform is to be worn completely and correctly at all times on and off campus. Girls are not to roll up skirts to shorten the length. Skirts must be touching the knee when standing straight. Secondary students are not to roll up sleeves and must wear the top button done up when wearing the tie.

However, the uniform is a vital representation of the school and its ethos, value base and placement as a private school. Therefore, the College enforces the adherence of the uniform policy. The school expects support from parents in directing their students to wear the uniform as required.

Jumper:	College jumper available from College uniform shop. Jumper can be worn with the formal dress uniform and the sport uniform. No other jumpers will be accepted. The College Sports Jacket can be worn over the College jumper for extra warmth. It cannot be worn with the formal uniform without the College jumper.
